Annual Parish Meeting Agenda Items and Elections for the 2020 Council

Annual Parish Meeting Agenda Items: Anyone who wishes to present an agenda item should submit the topic in writing to Fr. James Weremedic by Sunday, October 20, 2019.

The Parish Council Nominating Committee consists of Fr. James Weremedic, Rector, Odess Remington, Vice-President, and Claire Remington, Recording Secretary and is accepting nominations at this time.

Parishioners who are interested in serving on the 2020 Parish Council should contact Fr. James,

Claire, or Odess as soon as possible. Please review the positions and the required qualifiers listed. The complete procedures can be found in the Parish by-laws. The following qualifiers are a subset from the by-laws.

The Elected Officers:

- The election of President, Vice-President, Financial Secretary, Recording Secretary, and Treasurer shall be elected for a term of one year.
- The election of lay members to the Parish Council will include no less than 6 members and no more than 12 members who want to be on the Parish Council, and shall be elected for a term of one year.
- Three (3) auditors shall be elected for a term of one year.
- A delegate and an alternate delegate for the Diocesan Assembly shall be elected for a term of one year. **Deadline for Nominations is Sunday, October 20, 2019.**

Our 2020 Parish Council consists of the Rector, 5 Officers and 8 Council Members.

- a) Eligibility for Nomination. To be qualified for election to the Parish Council, a candidate must:
 - i) be 21 years of age or over;
 - ii) be a voting member of the Parish for at least two years;
 - iii) have fulfilled the canonical requirements of the Faith, as verified by the Rector; and
 - iv) be a person of the Church in conduct and speech (Standards are obviously higher for those who choose to serve in a leadership capacity)
- b) Nominees. The Nominating Committee shall have more than the number of vacancies to be filled.
 - i) Must indicate their willingness to serve if elected
 - ii) Must give permission for a free background check conducted by the Rector as required by the state of Pennsylvania
- c) **Nominating Committee Report** shall be provided to the Council President and read to the Parish Council prior to the Annual Parish Meeting. The approved report shall be included in the minutes of the <u>Annual Parish Meeting</u>.
- d) **No Nominations from the Floor.** No additional nominations may be made from the floor of the annual Parish meeting in order to avoid embarrassing anyone who may not meet the requirements due to background check laws.

Election and Composition. The affairs of the Parish shall be managed, directed, and administered by a governing body which shall be named the Parish Council. The Parish Council shall consist of:

- a) The Rector
- b) Parish Council President
- c) Vice-President
- d) Financial Secretary
- e) Recording Secretary
- f) Treasurer
- g) Six (6) or twelve (12) council trustees elected by the voting membership at the Annual Parish Meeting
